

GEOLOGY 1121 - GENERAL PHYSICAL GEOLOGY
MAP EXERCISE / WORLD GEOGRAPHY REVIEW

This exercise is intended to re-familiarize you with the basic geography of the world, and particularly with places we'll be mentioning in class. I will expect you to be able to locate these features on an exam, not all at once, but at least five per exam. I will probably use locations that are relevant to lecture material. This exercise must be completed and you are strongly urged to use an atlas or any other good reference. Some of this information may be found in your textbook. Most will be found in any good atlas – several are available online. National Geographic's web site is also good.

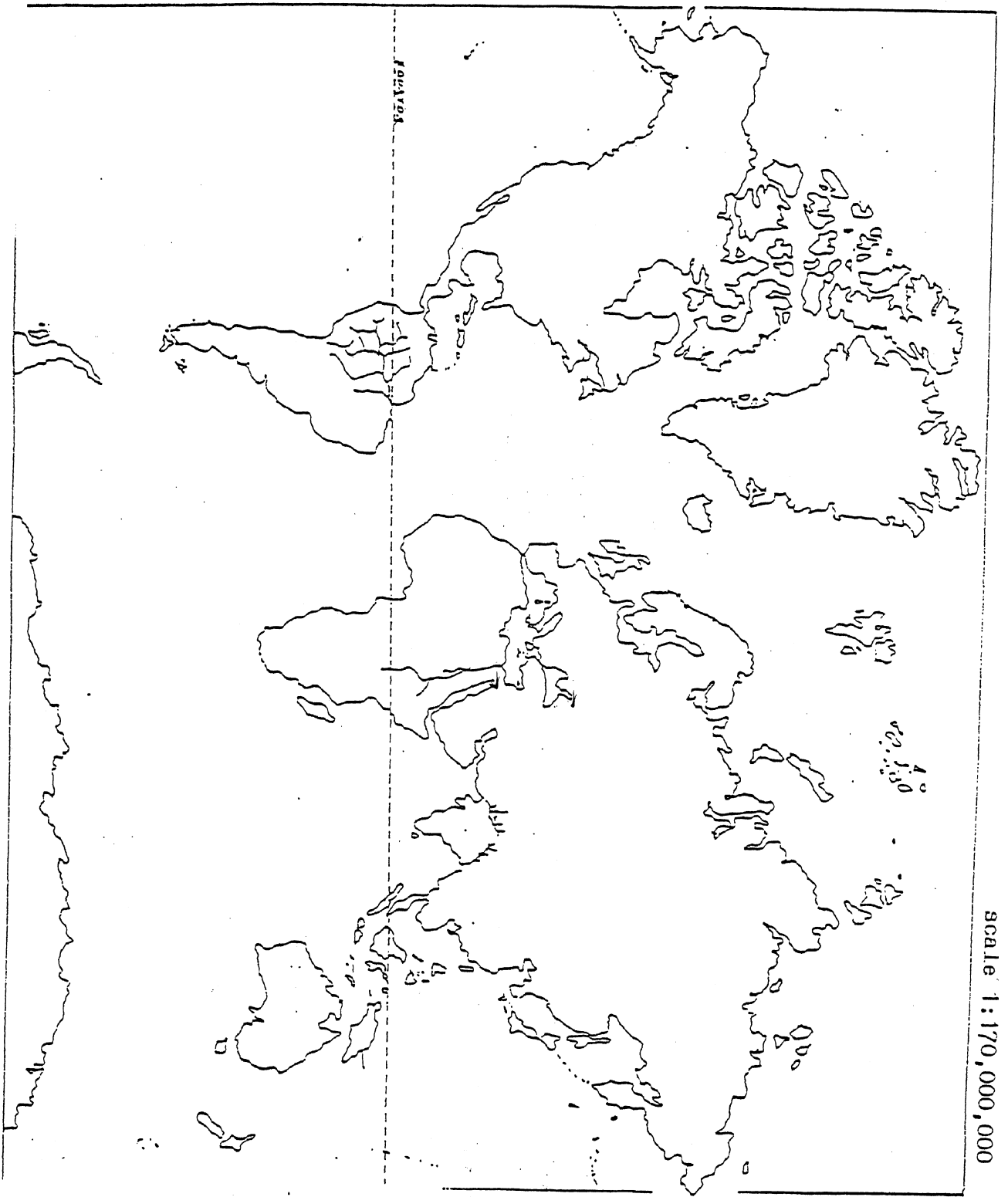

If the feature is small, write your label in an open area and use an arrow to show precisely where the feature is located. On exams, your locations must be precise for you to receive credit.
